Please find attached the community emergency plans of Pocklington Town Council, Bridlington Town Council and Driffield Town Council as requested. The plans have been redacted to remove personal information.

I have taken the definition of "principle towns" from the East Riding Local Plan, which are Bridlington, Beverley, Driffield and Goole. Goole Town Council is in the process of preparing a plan. Beverley Town Council has asked that we do not share their plan.
