3) TYLER update

TYLER where successful in their application to the [Redacted] for £4,500 to deliver Independent Living Skills Training to young people. They are working with ERYC education and employment team on the programme, which they aim to trial in April 2019 to roll out in September 2019. AW doesn't have confirmed details yet but thinks the course will be for 14-25 year olds and will run for 10 weeks. TYLER will be interviewing presenters before the training programme starts.

TYLER is visiting the 0-25 team at the hub to find out more about what they are doing, working on a new TYLER leaflet, continuing promoting the anti-bullying survey, having a Christmas treat at White Rabbit cafe and hope to run some open events next year to increase membership. LG suggested asking Jackie Lown to send TYLER members a Christmas Card.
