7) AOB

[Redacted] updated the group about concerns she has regarding data protection and confidentiality, as parent carers have feedback that they sometimes don't know who they are meeting with and why. [Redacted] suggested contact cards could be left with parent carers with staff's contact details on. [Redacted] feedback to the group that they ask parent carers to sign consent forms, and he is going to speak to his line manager about how they can improve how they communicate their involvement/engagement. The group suggested that a copy of the consent form is left with parent carers so they know what they have signed.

[Redacted] asked how the High Needs Strategic Review fits into the SEND Strategy and [Redacted] and this group. The recommendations from the High Needs Strategic Review are included in the Strategy and the SEF.
